



Admission to Teacher Education Candidacy: Five Requirements

1. Attain junior status of 60 hours.
2. Maintain an overall GPA of 2.5 on coursework taken at NC State.
3. Successful completion of the general education requirements for English and Mathematics. This includes ENG 101, the 4.0 hour "Academic Writing and Research" course and the two appropriate mathematics courses required by the major.
4. Successfully complete the appropriate "Introduction to Teaching" course.
5. Pass all three parts of PRAXIS I (PPST) or satisfy the requirement through the exemption policy. Required passing scores and exemptions are listed below:

| 1. Effective 5/3/07 Students with a composite score of 522 across all three areas of the Praxis I exam shall be deemed to have met the testing requirement. |

Effective 1/5/06 <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students with a total SAT score of 1100 are exempt from Praxis I requirements.• Students with a total SAT score less than 1100, but with a score of at least 550 on the Math test are exempt from the Praxis I Math test.• Students with a total SAT score less than 1100, but with a score of at least 550 on the Critical Reading (verbal) test are exempt from the Praxis I Reading and Writing tests. |

Effective 1/5/06 <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students with a composite ACT score of 24 are exempt from Praxis I requirements.• Students with a composite ACT score of less than 24, but with a score of at least 24 on the English test are exempt from the Praxis I Reading and Writing tests.• Students with a composite ACT score of less than 24, but with a score of at least 24 on the Math test are exempt from the Praxis I Math test. |
