Students will know the schedule a full year in advance and will not have meetings scheduled on the 2<sup>nd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> weekends. This program is targeted for the working professional seeking to develop the skills needed to be effective leaders and complete their degree, including the dissertation, in a 3-year period.
